





## INTRODUCTION FROM THE CEO WELCOME TO OUR SUSTAINABILITY UPDATE



At Forterra our purpose is to keep Britain building. Our products help to create homes, communities and infrastructure which will last for generations. The continued achievement of this goal will only be possible through attaining the highest standards of stewardship of our natural resources, care for our planet, and the support of our employees and society.

I'm pleased to report that over the last five years our carbon emissions intensity (per tonne of production) has reduced by 10%, with corresponding reductions in mains water usage, and waste to landfill of 27%, and 57% respectively.

It is now over ten years since our flagship Measham brick facility in Leicestershire was commissioned. Measham produced more than 100m Ecostock bricks in 2019 and these are now at the forefront of our offer. Our commitment to investing in highly energy efficient facilities is continuing with our new Desford brick facility, due to commence commissioning in 2022.

The humble clay brick has stood the test of time due to its versatility, reliability and robustness as a cladding material built to last. But we also recognise our markets are evolving and seeking increased offsite solutions via modern methods of construction, focused on low wastage and efficient speed of build. In 2019 we launched a number of offsite walling products including our SureBrick façade system, integrated brick faced concrete panels, and the Quickwall system, providing alternative solutions to traditional construction.

Turning to our operations, we have now completed the conversion of our entire aircrete block operations to enable the use of conditioned fuel ash, a reclaimed material stockpiled across UK power stations which ensures that we continue to minimise the use of virgin materials in one of our most sustainable products.

The support of our employees and local communities is critical to our achievements. In 2019 our investment in the next generation of our people saw apprentice and graduate numbers rise further to 38, and 55 employees have now undertaken our expanded leadership development programme. Our community and charity focus has included skills collaboration with 10 brick colleges, and the support of a community build project in Malawi.

The Covid-19 pandemic has brought huge challenges to the business. However, I can reflect with pride on both our commitment to the health, safety and wellbeing of our employees over this difficult time, and also our collective spirit and drive in adapting to this changing environment.

I believe that now, more than ever, is the right time to increase our ambitions and accelerate our progress on sustainability. Introduced in the 2019 annual report, our three sustainability pillars of People, Planet and Product will guide our future decision making, and I have recently commissioned specific task-force groups focused on key priorities of renewable energy investment, carbon emissions, and plastic packaging reduction.

I look forward to communicating our new challenging targets in more detail in early 2021, and hope you enjoy the following pages of this update which further highlight some of our sustainability credentials and recent achievements.
